

THE BASICS

- NO sunflower seeds, chewing gum, tobacco, or alcohol products.
- NO bikes, hover boards, scooters, roller blades, skateboards, etc.
- No metal-spiked shoes of any kind allowed on the turf.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

- Child must be at least 4 years old and no older than 7 as of January 1 of the current season calendar year.
- If the player's age is disputed and it is determined that the player is not age-eligible or not listed on the official team roster, the game will be declared a forfeit. The head coach could be subjected to disciplinary action as determined by the league.

MISCELLANEOUS

- T-Ball coaches may pick one (1) assistant coach prior to the player draw.
 - Only the coaches' children are guaranteed a spot on the team before the draw.
- Dugouts are restricted to current team players and coaches with a current, approved background check. This is non-negotiable and required due to insurance guidelines.

EQUIPMENT

- REQUIRED
 - Batters: Batting helmet with ear protection
 - Catchers: Protective headgear. No skull cap helmets allowed.
- 9" soft T-Ball

THE GAME

- All rules for OK Kids baseball will be followed, with the following exceptions:
 - The ball and batting tee are provided by the league for all league and tournament play.
 - All teams MUST use the ball and tee provided by the league.
- SCOREKEEPING
 - Scores will be kept during league and tournament play

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THE GAME

- LEAGUE PLAY
 - 5 Innings, 55 Minutes, or Run Rule
 - Run Rule: 13 after 3 OR 7 after 4
 - No new innings after 50 minutes. The umpire will use a timer to keep time.
 - Games can begin if the team(s) have only 8 players with NO automatic outs.
 - Team MUST bat all players on the roster
- TOURNAMENT PLAY
 - The game concludes at the end of the 55- minute time limit.
 - Games can begin if the team(s) have only 8 players, but must take an automatic out for batters #9 and #10.
- LEAGUE & TOURNAMENT PLAY
 - Each half inning ends
